What is the target market for this fund?

The target market of Sarasin Growth Fund covers retail, professional and eligible counterparty charities. It is suitable for basic, informed and advanced charities. It is compatible with charities who do not need a capital guarantee have the capacity to bear some loss and is therefore not suitable for wealth preservation investors who cannot bear capital loss. The product is suitable to be held on a standalone basis as a solution to a charities investment needs and is suited to charities with a relatively high-risk appetite. It is suitable for charities that require ready access to liquidate their investment and the product has a long-term (i.e. >5 years) recommended holding period.

Negative target markets

Non-UK charity investors are considered to be a negative target market for this product.

What are the distribution channels for this fund?

This product is expected to be distributed to UK charities that are basic, informed or advanced retail or professional consumers, or eligible counterparties. This may be on an execution-only basis, following an appropriateness test and/or investment advice, or through portfolio management.

Does this fund have specific features and/or restrictions?

This product aims to avoid investment in companies which are materially engaged in certain sectors, including alcohol, tobacco, armaments, gambling and adult entertainment.
